#### November 30, 2020

#### 1. INVESTMENT POSITION

The District's Investments continue to be consistent with the Investment Policy of seeking safety of capital, liquidity, and return on investment. Thus, as of November 30, 2020, all funds were invested in either, Wells Fargo Bank's High Yield Money Market, Bond Debt Service Funds (secured by US Government agency obligations), Certificates of Deposit, Advisor Sweep account or Tex-Pool (The Texas Investment Pool service for Public Funds sponsored by the State Comptroller).

#### 2. BOOK AND MARKET VALUES

Because of the nature of the District's Investments, book value and market value are the same for each fund, which had balances as of November 30, 2020 as follows (with the current rate of interest shown in parentheses):

#### 3. MATURITY DATES

All of the District's Investments are available for immediate withdrawal, except for the Bond Debt Service Funds which are set aside for payment on the respective Bonds and cannot be withdrawn by the District.

#### 4. WELLS FARGO INVESTMENT ACCOUNTS

As of November 30, 2020 Wells Fargo held \$4,141,786 of total deposits of which FDIC insurance covered \$250,000 of those deposits. Deposits requiring collateral totaled \$3,891,786. As of November 30, 2020 BNY Mellon Bank held \$4,151,762 in fair market value FNMA and FNMS Notes in the Districts behalf for Wells Fargo Bank. Thus, the District is over collateralized in the amount of \$259,976.

#### 5. POOLED INVESTMENTS (Tex-Pool)

Tex-Pool is managed by Federated Investors which seeks to maintain a "net asset value" of \$1 per unit. Historically it has done so, and continues to do so. Due to an increase in interest rates on Tex-Pools accounts to an average of 2.00% as of mid 2018, the Board approve a transfer from the Wells Fargo MM account to the Tex-Pool General Fund in the amount of \$2,800,000 and the Reserve Account of \$580,000. Current balances as of November 30, 2020 in each respective accounts are \$2,912,861 and \$601,194 with an effective interest rate of .12%.

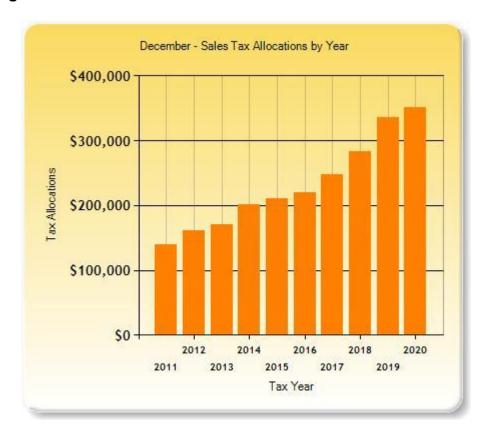
December 2020 Sales Tax Summary

Our December sales tax allocation was \$350,770. This was up 4.3% (+\$14,610) compared to December 2019 up 3.7% (+\$35,532) for the fiscal year to date. This was our highest ever December allocation.

Our top 10 large companies accounted for 55.2% (+\$72,782), our top 30 large companies accounted for 72.2% (+\$36,899), and our top 100 large companies accounted for 89.4% (+\$45,097) of our total fiscal year collections.

The out of state marketplace "Single Local Tax Rate" allocation for December was \$2,875 (+\$7,856 fiscal year to date).

The December allocation reflects sales made during the month of <u>October</u>. The data continues to show strong online retail trade performance. Our total annual sales tax allocation performance beginning from our implementation in 2004 is shown on the following page.

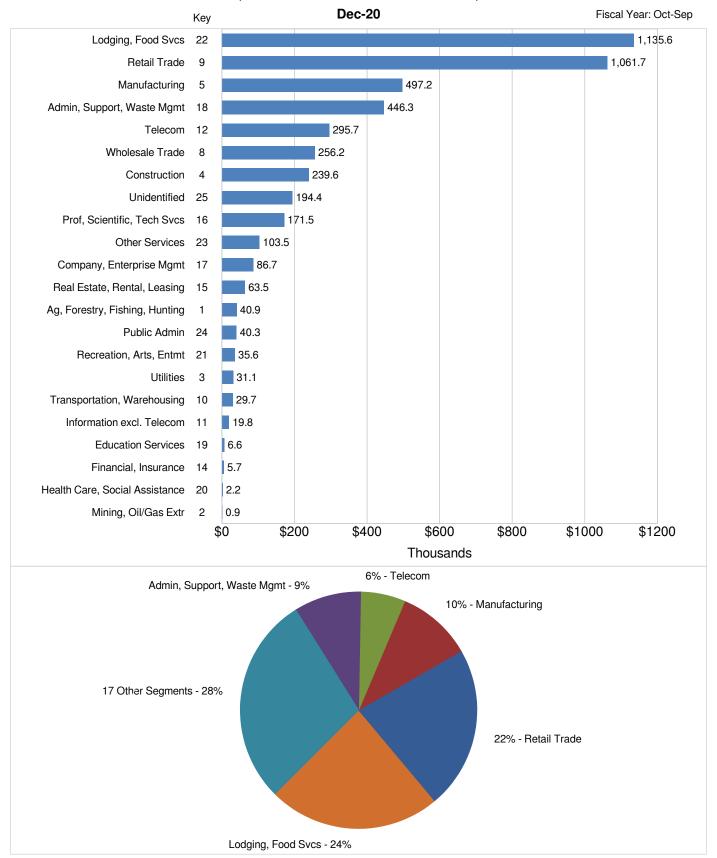

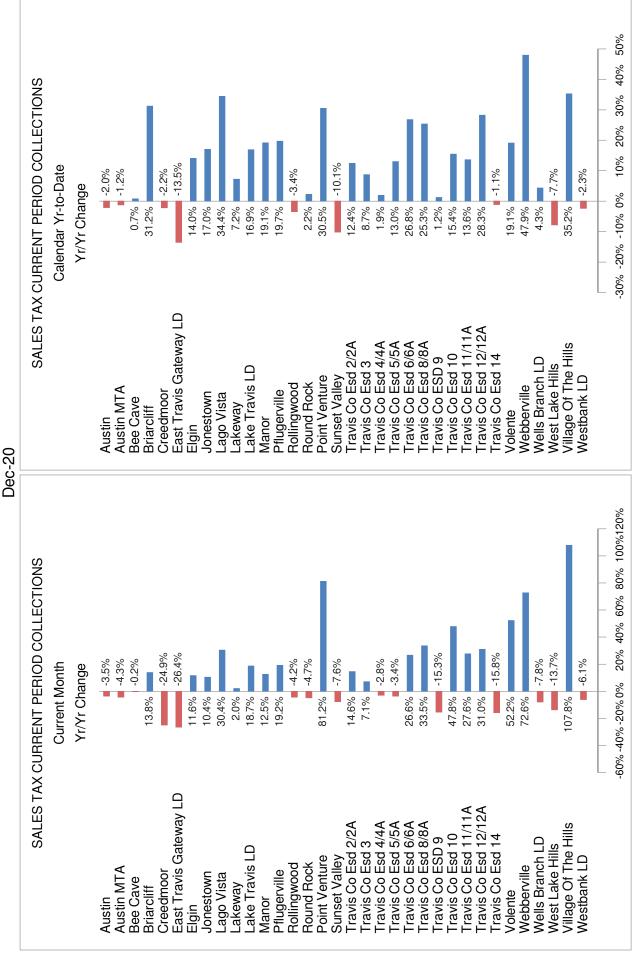

**November 2020 Report** 

#### **Significant Events**

November 6 (C) - Vehicle Extrication (AutoAid Received - Austin) - Barton Creek Blvd & Southwest Parkway

[QNT302] Quint 302 was called out for a reported MVA rollover. Arrived on the scene and had a 2 car MVA with one on the side rolled over off the road into the trees with a person still inside. Call was then upgraded to a Vehicle Rescue. Q302 pulled a line on the ground, pulled tools, and had E37 assist with stabilizing the vehicle. After further assessment, the windshield was removed and the person was helped out of the vehicle. Vehicle rescue was downgraded. EMS arrived and assessed the person. Second vehicle person refused care. Cleaned up the road and cleared E37. TCSO then cleared Q302.

#### November 20 (A) – Brush Fire – 11400 Antler Bend Rd

[BT301] Brush Truck 301 was called out for smoke investigation. On arrival, found a 2 acre brush fire behind a house and on some other land. BT301 found the land owner on the other side of the fence and she told us how to get around to her gate. BT301 drove around to meet her at her gate so she could let us in. Fire had stopped on its own, but some brush piles were still burning. BT301 put out brush piles and went around the perimeter of the fire to make sure it was all out. BT301 went through 3 tanks of water to get the fire out and cold with no smokes. After some time of making sure the fire was out and cold, BT301 then cleared the call.

[ENG301] Engine 301 called out to smoke investigation. On arrival, found a 2 acre brush fire. E301 crew parked on the road and went down to assist BT301 with putting out the fire. E301 used hand tools and red line to mop up the fire. After fire was out, E301 cleared the call.

November 30 (C) - Chimney Fire (AutoAid Received - Austin) - 9804 Derecho Dr [ENG301] Engine 301 responded to a structure fire on Derecho Drive. Upon arrival of the address, no fire was visible on the front exterior of the home. Three to four people were standing on the front deck with the door open and no fire was seen inside the house. E301 assumed command and was in investigation mode. Upon arrival at the front door, the home residents said their chimney was on fire and one person went on the roof to extinguish the fire with a garden hose. A 360 degree walk around the house did not reveal any fire, smoke, or high heat signatures from the TIC from the home. The inside living room had a little smoke and a smoldering fire was in the hearth. The adjoining walls were not hot to the touch or revealed any high heat signatures from the TIC. E43 arrived and assisted with deploying the extension ladder on the C side of the home to inspect the chimney and chimney chase. The second floor and attic were investigated and did not reveal any smoke, fire, or high heat signatures from the TIC. All units were canceled except E301 and E43. Two firefighters deployed to the roof and reported that the chimney cap and chase were cold to the touch with no high heat signatures from the TIC on the chase and surrounding areas near the chimney.

The homeowners said they started the fire with a wood log and then put a creosote log on top of the wood that was burning. The homeowners could detect something wasn't right and went outside to witness flames coming out of the chimney cap and 911 was called. The

homeowners said they periodically have fires at home, but it has been close to 10 years since they've had the chimney professionally cleaned. The roof team reported a heavy buildup of creosote near the chimney cap. E301 and E43 Lieutenants were comfortable that fire did not escape the flue and any high buildup of heat and smoke had dissipated. The homeowners were advised to remain aware of any buildup of heat or smoke and call 911 if needed. All units cleared.
