- 1) Balance Sheet The net cash balances have decreased by \$377,842 since October 31, 2023 for a total of \$15,986,051 in cash and investments.
- 2) Treasury Bills average rate of return is 5.33% (up .18%)
- 3) Certificate of Deposits average rate of return is 5.02%. (stable)
- 4) TexPool accounts average rate of return is 5.30% (down .16%)
- 5) Revenue & Expense November 2023 only. Interest Income up by \$26k and Sales Tax Collections are down by \$65k. Net Loss for November 2023 was (\$379,478) compared to last year's November 2022 net revenue of \$87,901.
 - Account 600 Emergency Response was up by \$118,449. Which includes Truck Repairs of \$72,017, Computers for trucks of \$34,002 and Travis County Annual radio fees of \$27,680.

December 2023 Sales Tax Summary

The December allocation reflects sales made during the month of October.

Our December 2023 sales tax allocation was \$537,490, which is up 4.7% (+\$23,942) compared to December 2022 and up 2.6% (+\$40,310) year to date compared to last year.

Our top 10 large companies accounted for 61.9%, our top 30 large companies accounted for 73.5%, and our top 100 large companies accounted for 87.4% of our total fiscal year collections.

Notable reductions continued in the construction sector, from both cement and building supply vendors as well as landscaping companies. Sales Tax allocation from the gas pipeline in our area was also down this month compared to December 2022. We did see several new companies with allocations that were not reporting last December.

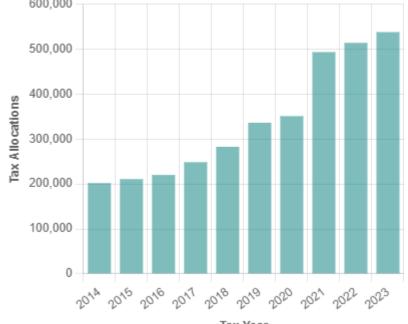

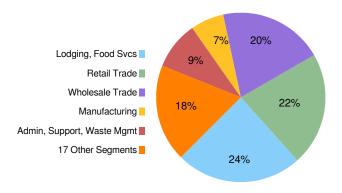

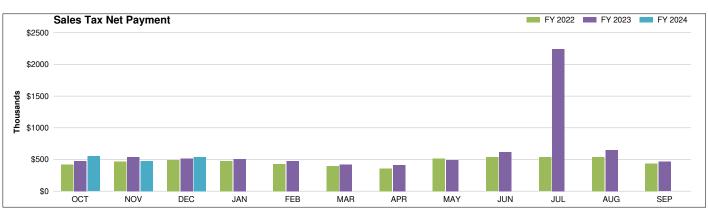

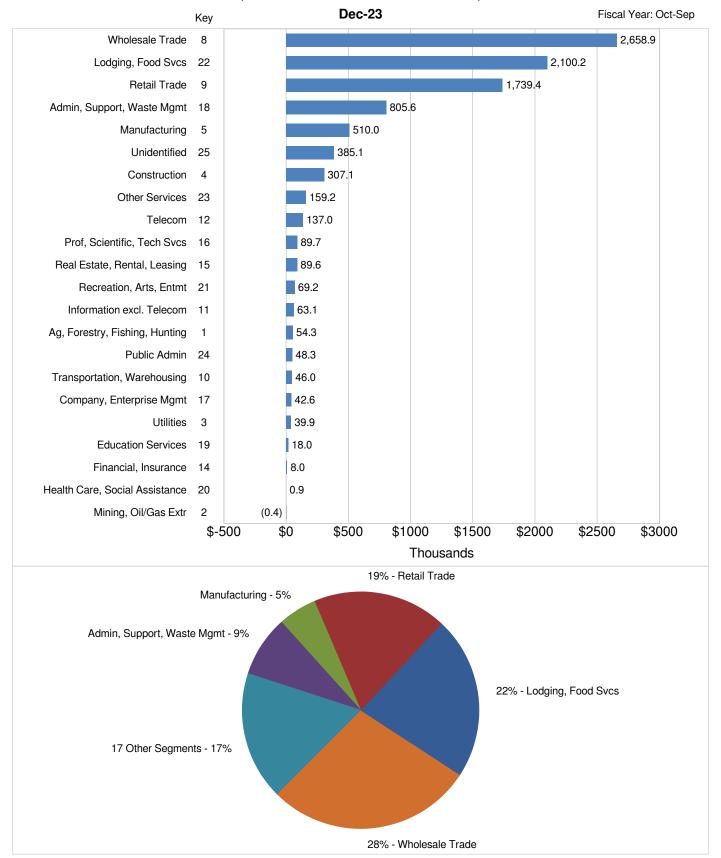

INDUSTRY SEGMENT SALES TAX RANK & DISTRIBUTION

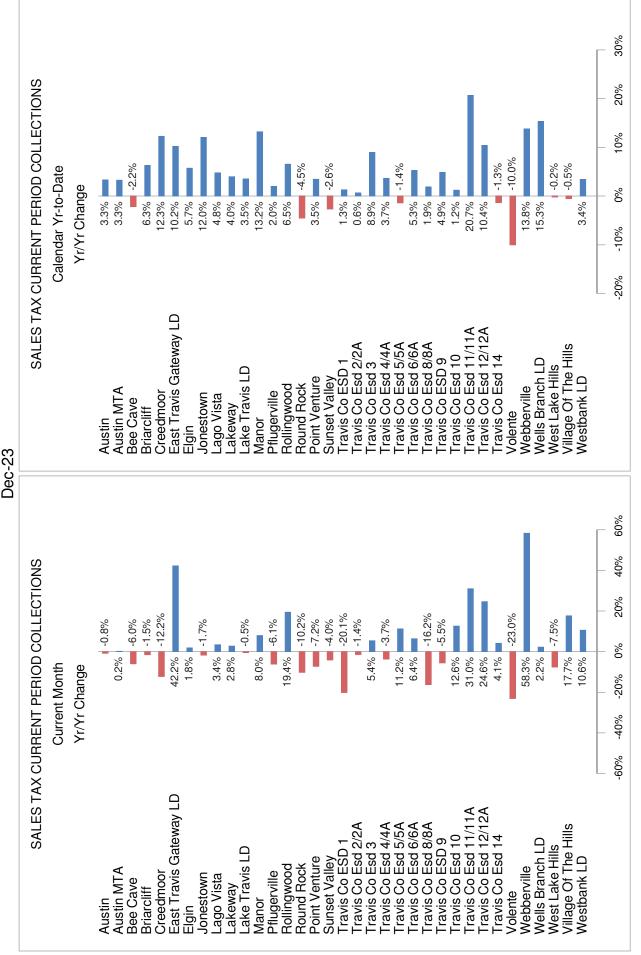

December 2023 Chief's Report

Significant Events

November 13 (B) – Vehicle Fire – AutoAid Given (Austin) – 8301 Gallatin Dr [Engine 301] E301 was assigned to an 'Auto Fire' in the CoA. E301 arrived and found an old VW bus with heavy smoke coming from the rear engine compartment. The vehicle was parked in the street, with no exposures. E301 pulled our bumper line and extinguished the fire. We then used water to cool the vehicle until the TIC showed no more hotspots.

November 26 (B) – Structure Fire – AutoAid Given (Austin) – 5212 Crystal Water Dr [Truck 302] TK302 responded code 3 to a structure fire. While responding, units on scene went from investigation to offensive mode. As TK302 was arriving on scene, Command had TK302 level one stage while crews checked for extension in a wall section of the residence. After crews inside had determined the fire to be extinguished, Command cleared TK302 off the call. TK302 cleared off the call and returned to service.

November 27 (C) – Structure Fire – AutoAid Given (CE-Bar) – 2021 River Hills Rd [Truck 302] TK302 was dispatched out for a reported box alarm in ESD 9 area. TK302 responding and arrived on the scene to stage. TK302 Officer went to the Command Post and requested assignment and was assigned Inside Division. Made entry to the house to find crews working on overhaul of the area of origin. Light smoke was still in the house and had E1001 up in the attic checking for extension. No heat was found in the attic from thermal scan. Had crews continue to check the area and work on salvage. Ventilation had started to remove smoke from the house and the attic. E1001 came back down and had picked up their hose line. I had TK302 crew enter the attic and continue to check the area and clear the insulation from the hole that was put in the ceiling by the crews. Command then entered the structure and gave him an update on the status. Command then cleared TK302.

[Battalion 302] BAT302 responded to a structure fire in ESD 9. Upon arrival, Command asked BAT302 to locate a hydrant. By the time BAT302 was able to locate a hydrant, the crews had contained the fire to the fireplace and there was no extension. Command cleared units and BAT302 went available.

Special Projects Status

- We recently participated with the Oak Hill Parkway agencies for a "touch-a-truck" event where the public was invited to view static displays of different equipment that work on or around the roadways every day. We provided the opportunity for people to see our truck and its equipment and to answer questions.
- I spent late last week at the Texas Fire Chiefs' Workshop in San Antonio where Fire Chiefs from across the state come together to discuss current issues. This also covers the 20 hours of annual Chief-level training required by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP). Topics covered include mental health, Electric Vehicles and Electric Storage Systems, Legislative reports, and presentations by State Agencies.

Our 90th percentile response travel time this month was 10:21 for all incidents. Our 50th percentile (median) response travel time this month was 4:44 for all incidents. Our average response travel time this month was 5:22 for all incidents.
