Minutes of Travis County Emergency Services District #3 May 26, 2011

Attached to and incorporated into these minutes is a copy of the official agenda for the May 26th 2011 meeting.

<u>Under Agenda Items 1 & 2</u>: President Edd New called the Travis County Emergency Services District #3 (TCESD 3, the District) Board of Commissioners' special meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. A quorum was established with Commissioners Bob Taylor, John Villanacci, Edd New; and Carroll Knight attending.

Fire department personnel present at the meeting included: Chief Warren; Assistant Chief Wittig; Business Mgr. Miller; District Chiefs Hartigan and Wilson; Captain Patton; Firefighters Bluemel, Grieser, and Schminke; and PIO Warren.

<u>Under Agenda Item 3</u>: President New announced that the County Commissioners need each Emergency Services District to rank proposals for some kind of county-wide department or provide a better solution, if anyone knows of one. The three proposals that emerged from the May 7th meeting of the Emergency Services Districts' Commissioners Council (ESDCC) are:

Travis County ESD 15 – "Overlay ESD" Metro Fire Department Travis County Fire Department

Commissioner Taylor refreshed all present with a review of each proposal, mentioning their structure, advantages, and hurdles. Commissioner Taylor fielded questions and general discussion developed. Also at hand, each commissioner had a summary of the Emergency Services Standards Advisory Team (ESSAT) responses to questions that had arisen during the May 7th meeting.

Commissioner Taylor moved to rank the Travis County Fire Department First; the Travis County ESD 15 Second; and the Metro Fire Department Third. Commissioner Villanacci requested a stipulation to be added regarding annexation issues. Commissioner Taylor then rephrased the motion to 'rank the Travis County Fire Department First; the Travis County ESD 15 Second; and the Metro Fire Department Third with the proviso that an agreement to resolve annexation issues must be reached if either Travis County Fire Department or Travis County ESD 15 is ranked Number One by a majority of Travis County ESDs'. Commissioner Knight seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

<u>Under Agenda Item 4</u>: Commissioner Taylor moved to authorize President New to put out feelers to other contiguous ESDs regarding possible discussions of management-sharing plans and to arrange with the board of Travis County ESD9 (TCESD9) to meet and discuss ESD3's and ESD9's mutual goals and to make TCESD9 aware of the proposed contacts with other ESDs. Commissioner Villanacci seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

<u>Under Agenda Item 5</u>: There were no closed meetings.

<u>Under Agenda Item 6</u>: There being no further business, Commissioner Villanacci moved to adjourn at 8:50 p.m. Commissioner Knight seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
