The next Oak Hill EMT-B Academy will start on *September 13, 2010. The Academy will last 16 weeks and will be held on Monday and Wednesday nights from 18:00 to 22:00 and some Saturdays from 08:00 to 17:00. Upon successful completion of the EMT-B Academy, you will be eligible to test for the National Registry. This class is comprised of 180 hours of classroom and labs, a minimum of 8 hours of hospital Emergency Department Clinicals, and a minimum of 48 hours of ambulance field rotations.

The tuition for the class is \$775.00. Tuition includes a work t-shirt, all required books, facility fees, stethoscope, penlight, and use of a uniform shirt.

Items that you will need for the first day of class are Texas Department of Public Safety 3 year Driving record, criminal history record w/fingerprint card, your immunization record (that shows the following immunizations were received: Hep B (first dose started), Tetanus, TB Skin Test, MMR, Polio, and Chickenpox), navy blue work pants (Dickies, BDUs, or EMS pants), a black belt, and a pair of black shoes or boots (not cowboy boots).

Applications will be accepted beginning June 1, 2010. When the class fills up, any remaining applications will be placed on a waiting list in the order that they were received in case any openings develop.

Payment of all costs are due in full by the first day of class. A \$200.00 non-refundable deposit (which will be applied to your class cost) is due along with your application. Payments can then be made during regular business hours or by mail from June 1, 2010 to the end of the business day (5 PM) on September 13, 2010. The address where you can mail payments or pay in person is 4111 Barton Creek Blvd. Austin, Texas 78735. Please remember that the total amount you owe must be paid in full by the first day of class. Failure to pay in full by the first day of class will result in you being dropped from the class and your deposit will not be returned.
