## **COURSE OVERVIEW:**

The Emergency Medical Technician course is designed to prepare the student to enter the field of Emergency Medical Services at an entry level position. The course is taught to the National Educational Standards and exceeds the minimum number of course hours as required by the Texas Department of State Health Services.

When the student successfully completes the course, they are eligible to test for certification with the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians. Upon obtaining NR certification, the student is eligible to apply for certification with the Texas Department of State Health Services.
