Minutes of Travis County Emergency Services District #3 June 24, 2024

Attached to and incorporated into these minutes is a copy of the official agenda for the June 24,2024 meeting.

<u>Under Agenda Item 1 & 2</u>: Commissioner President Edd New called the Travis County Emergency Services District #3 (TCESD# 3, the District) Board of Commissioners' regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. A quorum was established with Commissioners John Villanacci, Carroll Knight, David Detwiler, and Matt Escobedo in attendance. Fire department personnel present at the meeting included: Chief Wittig, Business Manager Herb Holloway, Kevin Whitworth and David DeStefano of Texas Regional Bank, and Firefighters Barfield, Ford, and Patton.

Under Agenda Item 3: There were no comments.

<u>Under Agenda Item 4</u>: The minutes of the May 20, 2024 Regular meeting were reviewed. Commissioner Villanacci moved to approve. Commissioner Detwiler seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

The 6 million in total will be invested in United States Treasury Bills under the investment advisors of TRB Wealth Management LLC and Charles Schwab as the brokerage services. Commissioner Villanacci moved to approve. Commissioner Knight seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

- 1) Balance Sheet Cash and Investments stand at \$18,211,807 as of June 30, 2024, which is a increase of \$170,316 from the prior month.
- 2) Five CD's will mature prior to September 30th. Yields have been slowly dropping over the last 60 days. The one-year rate is hovering around 4.90%.
- 3) On July 18, 2024, the district was successful in liquidating the \$3m in SPDR treasury bill funds and moving an additional \$3m out of the Money Markey account for a total of \$6 million to Schwab Brokerage to purchase Treasury Bills in TCESD#3's name.
- 4) Revenue & Expense June 2024 only. Interest Income is up by \$17k. Property Tax is up by \$4k and Sales Tax down by \$85k. Emergency Response #600 is up by \$50k primarily due to the purchase of bunker gear and Motorola communications.
- 5) Year to date compared to same time last year. Revenue items are up by \$574k compared to last year (excluding TIFMAS of \$467K) and expenses are up by \$651k. Net Revenue for the nine months ended June 30, 2024 is \$1,735,312 or approximately \$200,000 a month.
- 6) Year to date Budget vs. Actual is on track for the last nine months regarding expenses (excluding Mackey Field). Revenue is \$1,349,968 over budget.
- 7) Net Certified Market Values for 2023 are \$7,664,290,282. Appraised values are \$7,247,679,150 and our TAXABLE values have decreased to \$5,530,028,973 due to Homestead CAP Limitations (freeze). A growing number of elderly homeowners.
- 8) Checks over \$2,000 are normal and explained in the memo, except for the purchase of 14 Handheld Radios of \$128,949 or \$10,000 each after add-ons.

July - Sales Tax Allocations by Year

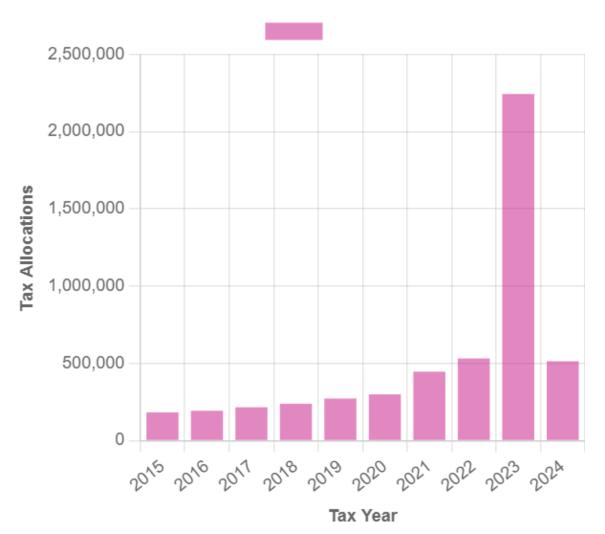

Significant Events
